

Invitation to the ONLINE election of the Youth Welfare Parents

Dear chairpersons of the Parents' Council,
Dear parents of a child in day care,

We would like to invite you to elect the new Parents Advisory Board.

According to the Child Education Act (Kibiz §11), the parents of the children from day care elect the youth welfare office parents council.

It is intended to ensure close cooperation between parents, the providers and the youth welfare office. In order to be able to presuppose a valid election, 15% of all parents (at least 43 parents of the day care centers and 360 parents of the day care children) must participate in the election.

Due the corona pandemic, the election of the Parents Advisory Board can only take place online.

You would like to run for election:

Representation and deputy of the parents' councils from day-care centers and any parent from day-care centers can stand for election. Fill in (see Appendix A at the <https://www.jaeb-essen.de/wahl-des-jaeb-2020-21>) and send it by e-mail to the Youth Welfare Parents Advisory Board. Closing date for entries is 25.10.2020.

You want to vote:

You follow the link of the Youth Welfare Office Parents' Advisory Board. Inform yourself about your candidates. As a parent of a Kita, you can elect up to 20 parent representatives from the List of Kitas. As a parent of a child in day care, you may elect up to three persons from the list of day care centre representatives. Elections can be made between November 1 2020 and November 7 2020. Your access data is only valid once.

You will find a sample of the election ballot on the website of the Youth Welfare Office Parents' Advisory Board. If you do not have a laptop, smartphone or tablet, you can vote at the Citizens' PCs in the Central Library Hollestr. 3, 45127 Essen with costs (30 minutes for 0.50 €).

The opening hours of the Central Library are Monday from 3 pm to 7 pm, Tuesday to Friday from 11 am to 7 pm and Saturday from 11 am to 3 pm.
